GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY (except Business of the Year and Lifetime Achievement and Care for Country Awards)

Please nominate individuals by using the following selection criteria:

- Nominees for NAIDOC SA Awards must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent.
- Applicants for the Young Person of the Year Award must be aged between 17-25 years of age.
- Applicants for the Elder of the Year Award must be aged 60 years and over.
- The Scholar of the Year Award will be judged on achievement in secondary and tertiary achievement.
- Nominees for the Apprenticeship / Traineeship Award must have completed their formal Apprenticeship / Traineeship or comparable training in the 12 months prior to NAIDOC Week 2019. Proof of completion should be included.
- Only visual or performing artists including musicians are eligible for the Artist of the Year.
- Presentation of the NAIDOC 2019 Awards will be made at the Aboriginal Flag Raising Ceremony and Lord Mayor's Morning Tea on.
- Award recipients are required to be available for photo and media opportunities.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD ELIGIBILITY

Please nominate individuals for the Lifetime Achievement Award using the following selection criteria:

- Demonstrated community involvement and commitment at the local, regional, state-wide and/ or national levels
- The individual's contribution is worthy of being recognised, and they have demonstrated exemplary leadership skills
- The individual is an inspirational role model for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and the broader Australian population
- The individual's achievements and commitment span many years
